



Dear Potential 2025 Season Sponsor,

We invite you to support athletes participating in the 11th season of the Taos Area High School Mountain Bike Team, "Taos Composite" and the 5th year of the middle school team. Base right here in Taos and representing Northern New Mexico, the high school team is a Colorado League sanctioned team (www.coloradomtb.org) competing in 5 races in Colorado and the middle school team is a New Mexico NICA sanctioned team (www.newmexicomtb.org) competing in 4 races in New Mexico.

Why support us? Taos Composite has much to offer our high school and middle school athletes: as a team we learn skills quickly, receive valuable coaching, and inspire each other to achieve. We set goals and work collaboratively to not only attain these goals, but to also develop a wide range of effective skills. Most importantly, this team is about setting high goals, improving skills, developing strong character and good judgment, and achieving personal bests. This is a cross-country mountain bike team, a specific form of cycling which is set apart from other cycling disciplines. The goal of our coaches is to provide students that have the desire to mountain bike the direction and camaraderie that will help them achieve both competitive success and personal development in a safe and enjoyable environment.

In 2024, we had 32 athletes participate. On our high school team, we had 20 from 3 local high schools and 3 schools outside of Taos. The Colorado League has over 1500 high school athletes racing. Our high school team raced in Division 3 and had great success with more individual and team podium finishes than ever. The successes of this team included personal growth, great improvement in strength and skills, and an incredible team spirit. Our middle school team had 12 athletes in 2024 and competed in the NMICL race series, with many podium appearances including at State Championships.

Taos Composite's high school team competes on a very big stage in Colorado and the middle school team is helping lead the way in New Mexico. We are able to do this thanks to amazing sponsorship support, involved parents, and committed coaches and athletes. Each year, we aim to secure enough sponsorship funds to cover all costs related to each athlete traveling to Colorado for events as well as to help defray the cost of equipment related to the team (bikes for athletes who do not have an appropriate bike, helmets, tools).

Race costs we hope to cover with sponsorships for the high school team are \$1200 per event (including all associated expenses) as we travel and stay overnight for each race due to driving distance. **Middle school race weekends require \$700 in sponsorship per race. We would be honored if you would consider being an event sponsor or co-sponsor!
